⇒ **Get ready!** You are beginning an exciting adventure with God!

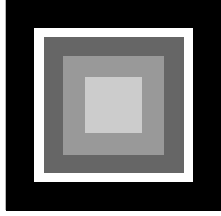
⇒ **Get set!** The Holy Spirit, your Teacher, will lead you to the feet of Jesus where you can listen and learn and love and grow!

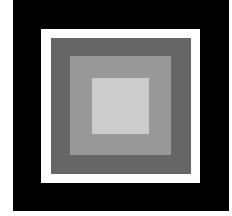
*“Now then, my sons, listen to me; pay attention to what I say.” Proverbs 7:24*

It's hard to listen to someone if we don't know where they are. Let's look at the Bible to see where God is.



Let's read  
Galatians 2:20

“Christ l \_ \_ \_ \_ i \_ m \_.”

Christianity is a relationship with Jesus, the King of all Kings. Jesus came to earth to communicate directly with us. He had to take our place as a substitute sacrifice and die, live again to prove His victory and His power over death, and sit at God's right hand to intercede for us. # Hearing God's voice according to Habakkuk



## Habakkuk 2:1,2

"I will **stand** on my **guard post**  
And station myself on the rampart;  
And I will keep **watch** to **see** what He will **speak** to me,  
And how I may reply when I am reproved.  
Then the Lord **answered** me and said,  
"**Record the vision**  
And inscribe it on tablets..."

- ⇒ **Habakkuk went to a place where he could be alone and become still.** "...I will stand on my guard post..."
- ⇒ **He watched to see what God would say.** "...and I will keep watch..."
- ⇒ **He tuned to the flow of words and pictures.** "...to see what He will speak to me..."
- ⇒ **He wrote down what he saw.** "...record the vision..."

# Steps to hearing God's voice

## 1. I quiet myself.

Ps. 46:10- "Be still and know that I am God."

## 2. I picture Jesus.

Hebrews 12:1-2 - "...let us run the race God has set before us. We do this by keeping our eyes on Jesus..."

## 3. I tune to the flow of words and pictures that gently light upon my heart.

John 7:38 - "Rivers of living water will flow from the heart of anyone who believes in Me."

## 4. I write it down.

Revelation 1:11 - "Write in a book what you see."

### Special Key

Stay focused on Jesus and not on what or who I am praying about.
