THE HOLY SPIRIT IN THE CHRISTIAN LIFE

Rom 8:9 They who have the Spirit belong to Christ.

Rom 8:15 We received not the Spirit of bondage but of adoption, “whereby we cry, Abba, Father”

Rom 8:16 “The Spirit himself beareth witness with our spirit, that we are children of God”

Gal 3:2 The Spirit is received by the hearing of faith.

There are several expressions of some particular aspect of the Spirit’s work in believers.

“**first-fruits**” **Rom 8:23**, ἀπαρχή, *aparchē*), which means that the present possession of the Spirit by the believer is the guarantee of the full redemption which is to come, as the first-fruits were the guarantee of the full harvest.

“**earnest**” **2Co 1:22; 5:5**, ἀρραβών, *arrabōn*), which also means a pledge or guarantee.

“**sealing**” of the Christians with the Holy Spirit of promise, as in **Eph 1:13** (ἐσφραγίσθητε, *esphragísthēte*, “ye were sealed”). This refers to the seal by which a king stamped his mark of authorization or ownership upon a document.
