
SPIRITUAL GIFTS INVENTORY

This inventory consists of a number of statements about ideas, attitudes, and behavior that may or may not be true about you. Each statement should be evaluated as to whether it is truly representative of you or not.

For example: "I would rather read the book than see the movie."



Your choice ranges from 1 through 7 as to whether or not this is true of you. Please do not mark column (4), marked "sometimes", more than twenty times.

This is not a test. There is no right or wrong answer. Your choice in each instance must be made in terms of what you really like and how you feel at the present time. Your choices should be a personal description of your own true, personal inclinations. Do not answer in terms of how you think you should respond how you want to be, but in terms of how you instinctively are.

Make one choice for each statement. Try to respond objectively to each statement without trying to second-guess the objective. Don't linger too long over the statements. Your first impression is usually the best.
