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CLOTHED WITH THE SPIRIT

(from “Redemption Tidings”)

God has a plan for us in this life of the Spirit, this abundant life. Jesus came that we might have life. Satan comes to steal and kill and destroy, but God has for us abundance, full measure, pressed down, shaken together, overflowing, abundant measure. God filling us with His own personality and presence, making us salt and light and giving us revelation of Himself. God with us in all circumstances afflictions, and persecutions, in every trial, girding us with truth. Christ the initiative, the Triune God in control, our every thought, word, and action must be in line with Him, with no weakness or failure. Our God is a God of might, light, and revelation, preparing us for heaven. *“Our life is hid with Christ in God; when He who is our life shall be manifested, we also shall appear with Him in glory.”* (Colossians 3:3-4)

THE EARNEST OF THE SPIRIT

2 Corinthians 5:1-6: *“For we know that if our earthly house of this tabernacle were dissolved, we have a building of God, a house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens. For we that are in this tabernacle do groan, being burdened, not that we would be unclothed but clothed upon, that mortality might be swallowed up of life. Now He that hath wrought for us the self-same thing is God, Who also hath given us the earnest of the Spirit.”* God’s Word is a tremendous Word, a productive Word, producing what it is - power. Producing God-likeness. We get to heaven through the Word of God, we have peace through the blood of His cross. Redemption is ours through the knowledge of the Word. I am saved because God’s Word says so (Romans 10:9). *“If thou shalt confess with thy mouth the Lord Jesus, and shalt believe in thy heart that God hath raised Him from the dead, thou shalt be saved.”* If I am baptised with the Holy Spirit it is because Jesus said that ye shall receive power, the Holy Ghost coming upon you. We must all have one idea - to be filled with the Holy Ghost, to be filled with God.

Message in Tongues

“God hath sent His Word to free us from the law of sin and death. Except we die we can not live; except we cease to be, God can not be.”

The Holy Ghost has a royal plan, a heavenly plan. He came to unveil the King, to show the character of God, to unveil the precious blood. As I have the Holy Spirit within me, I see Jesus clothed for humanity; He was moved by the Spirit, led by the Spirit. We read of some who heard the Word of God but were not profited, because faith was lacking in them. We must have a living faith in God’s Word, quickened by the Spirit. A man may be saved and still have a human spirit; with many who are spoken to about the Baptism of the Holy Ghost, the human spirit at once arises against the Holy Spirit. The human spirit is not subject to the law of God, neither can it be. The disciples at one time, wanted to call down fire from heaven. Jesus said, *“Ye know not what spirit ye are of.”*

Verse 5: *“Now He that hath wrought us for the self-same thing is God, Who also hath given us the earnest of the Spirit.”* The clothing upon of the Spirit, human depravity covered, all contrary to the mind of God destroyed. God must have bodies for Himself, perfectly prepared by the Holy Ghost, for the day of the Lord. Verse 2: *“For in this we groan, earnestly desiring to be clothed upon with our house which is from heaven.”* Is Paul speaking here of the coming of the Lord? No; yet it is in conjunction, this condition of preparedness. The Holy Ghost is coming to take out a church and a perfect Bride; He must find in us perfect yieldedness, every desire subjected to Him. He has come to reveal Christ in us, that the glorious flow of the life of God may outflow, rivers of living water to the thirsty land. Romans 8:10: *“If Christ be in you, the body is dead because of sin, but the Spirit is life because of righteousness.”*

THE PLAN OF THE SPIRIT

Message in Tongues

“This is that which God hath declared, freedom from the law. If we love the world, the love of the Father is not in us.” (1 John 2:16). *“For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father but is of the world.”*

The Spirit has to breathe in a new tenancy, a new order. He came to give the vision of a life in which Jesus is perfected. *“Who hath saved us and called us with a holy calling, not according to our works, but according to His own purpose and grace which was given us in Christ Jesus before the world began, but is now made manifest by the appearing of our Lord Jesus Christ, Who hath abolished death, and brought life and immortality to light through the Gospel.”* (2 Timothy 1:9-10) Saved, called to be saints, called with a holy calling, holy, pure, Godlike, sons with power. It is a long time now since it was settled and death abolished. Death has no more power; mortality is a hindrance; sin has no more dominion; you reign in Christ, you appropriate His finished work. Don't groan and travail for a week if you are in need, only believe. Don't fight to get some special thing, only believe. It is according to your faith. God blesses you with faith. Have faith in God. If you are free in God, believe, and it shall be.

“If ye then be risen with Christ, seek the things that are above, where Christ is seated at the right hand of God.” Stir yourselves up, beloved; where are you? I am risen with Christ, planted. It was a beautiful planting. Seated. God gives me credit and I believe Him; why should I doubt?

“Wherefore do you doubt? Faith reigns. God makes it possible. How many receive the Holy Ghost and Satan gets a doubt in? Don't doubt; believe. There is power and strength in Him; who dares believe God?”

Quit Doubting Street; live in Faith-Victory Street. Jesus sent seventy away, and they came back in victory. It takes God to make it real. Dare to believe till there is not a sick person, no sickness, everything withered, and the life of Jesus implanted within.

THE MINISTRY OF THE FLAMING SWORD

(from “Redemption Tidings”)

This glorious inworking of Holy Ghost power is preparing us for rapture. Our greatest theme, the glory of the splendour of our Lord. His face! His tenderness! His sweetness! Making our hearts long to be forever with the Lord. Amen! So let it be!

Romans 8:35-39: *“What shall we say to these things. If God be for us, who can be against us? Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword? Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him that loved us. For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers nor things present, nor things to come, nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Jesus Christ our Lord.”*

Oh the joy of the thought of it! What shall separate us from the love of Christ? A place of confidence, assurance, and rest, where God has perfect control over all human weakness. You stand as on the mount of transfiguration manifested and glorified as in the presence of God, able to say, I know all things are working together for good within me, silently destroying all that can be destroyed that He might have pre-eminence in the body. If God be for us who can be against us?

God is bringing forth a new creation; the Sons of God are to be manifested, and we must see our inheritance in the Holy Ghost. Nothing can separate us! What is it God wants us to know? Right in our earthly temple God has brought forth a Son with power, with manifestation, with grace, crowned already in the earth, crowned with glory. *“The glory which Thou has given me I have given them, that they may be one even as we are.”* (John 17:22) The Spirit of the Lord is showing me that God must get a people who can see that from before the foundation of the world He has had them in His mind.

God has been delivering us through all of our difficulties. Where sin abounded He has brought in His grace. Where disease came in to steal our lives, God’s raised up a standard, and we are here, having come through our tribulation. God has been purifying us, strengthening us, and equipping us with Divine audacity by the power of Almightyness - till we can say, *“What shall we say then to these things? Shall we dethrone what we know up to the present time has equipped us and brought us through? Shall we allow our hearts to fail us in the day of adversity?”* No! That which God has already strengthened and perfected ... Weakness made strong! Corruption changed to purity! Knowing that the tribulation and the fire of God have purified us, what shall we say to these things? These light afflictions are working for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory.

The New Creation People have been in meetings where the glory of God has fallen and the expression of God has been upon everything; fortifications have been made in the body. The next morning the power of Satan has assailed, but the spiritual life ... the Son manifested the glory of the New Creation ... is already in our mortal body. But, the flesh is a battleground for the enemy and is tested. That which God is forming is

greater than the mortal body. The spirit, which is awakening into the glorious liberty of a Son of God, is greater. From perfection to perfection, it is this knowledge of what He has done - what shall we say? How shall we compare this with that which is to come? *“The flesh profiteth nothing but the Spirit of the living God. Though worms destroy this body, I have another life greater than this life which shall look upon God-which shall see Him in His perfection - which shall behold Him in His glory - which shall be changed like unto Him and be formed into Him.”*

By the presence of God, a new creation, a glorious celestial shall so clothe us that we shall be there in the presence of His likeness. Knowing this, shall I give place to the devil? Shall I fear? Shall I let my feelings change the experience of the Word of God? Shall I trust in my fears? No! A million times, no! There has never been any good thing in the flesh, but God has quickened the spirit till we live a new life divine over all time, and we are eternally shaped for God.

What shall we say? Are you going to let the past where God has wrought for you bring you to a place of distress, or are you standing to your testing - *“Now are we the Sons of God.”* Are we remembering how God has answered our prayers, brought light into our home, delivered us from carnality and touched us when no power in the world could avail? What shall we say? Can anything be brought against the elect of God? I know in Whom I have believed and I am persuaded that He, Who purposed us for God, will surely bring us to the place where we shall receive the Crown of Life through the faith that God has given us. God is in you mightily, forming within you a new creation by the Spirit, to make you ready for the glory that shall be revealed in Him.

One said to me the other day, “I am in terrible trouble; a man is cursing me all the time.” If God be for us, who can be against us. God is never small in any of His blessings. He takes you into all He has, verse 33: *“He that spared not His own Son, how shall He not with Him freely give us all things.”* God has given us Jesus, the bosom of His love, the image of His Person, so perfect in brilliance, purity, righteousness and glory. I have seen Him many times and it always changes me. Your struggle is one of the all things. Many needs have broken my heart, but I could say to the troubled one, God is greater than your heart, greater than your circumstances, and greater than the thing that holds you. God will deliver you if you dare to believe Him, but we have to press it in and in and in before we can get the people to believe God.

A dear woman was marvellously delivered and saved, but she said I am so addicted to smoking, what shall I do? “Oh,” I said, “Smoke night and day.” She said, “In our circumstances we take a glass of wine and it has a hold on me.” “Oh,” I said, “Drink all you can.” It brought some solace to her, but she was in misery. She said, “We play cards.” I said, “Play on!” But after being saved she called her maid and said, “Wire to London and stop the shipment of those cigarettes.” The new life does not want it. It has no desire. The old is dethroned.

A clergyman came to me. He said, “I have a terrible craving for tobacco.” I said, “Is it the Old Man or the New?” He broke down. “I know it’s the Old,” he said. Put off the Old Man with his deeds. One said, “I have an unlawful affection for another.” I said, “You want revelation.” Seeing God has given you Jesus. He will give you all things. He will give you power over the thing, and it will be broken, and God broke it. “Allow

God to touch thy flesh.” Now He has quickened thy spirit. Allow Him to reign, for He shall reign until all is subdued. He is pre-eminently King in thy life over thy affection, thy will, thy desire, and thy plans. He rules as Lord of Hosts over thee, in thee, through thee, to chasten thee and bring thee to the perfection of thy desired haven. It is Christ in thee. It is the glory. “*Who shall separate us from the love of Christ?*” Once things could separate us, but they no more can. We have a vision. What is the vision? ... those days when we have eaten of the hidden manna.

THE SWORD

When I was baptised in the Holy Ghost, God showed me that when Adam and Eve transgressed and were turned out of the garden, at the gate was put a *flaming sword*, a sword of death, if they entered in. The Baptism of the Holy Ghost put the Tree of Life right in me and a flaming sword outside of me, to keep the devil from me, that I might eat all the time of eternal bread. I am eating of this wonderful bread of life. It is the life in the body, which has come to a perfect place to this life from which nothing can separate us. It is increasing tremendously, perpetually; rapture has something to do with it. In a moment this will clear out and leave the body. What is it? What shall separate us? Tribulations come, but they only press us in, press us nearer persecution, the finest thing that can come. There among the persecuted, you get the ripest, the holiest, the purest, the most intent. Filled with divine order, all things work for us. Nothing comes but what is helpful. Trials lift you, distresses give you a heave and sigh, but God causes us to triumph. Greater is He that is in you than all the powers of darkness.

Whatever befalls you, as you abide in Him, is the good hand of God upon you, so that you won't lose your inheritance. Every trial is a lift, every burden a place of exchanging strength. God will work. “*Who can lay anything to the charge of God's elect?*” People do it, but it makes no difference. God is for us. “*Eye hath not seen nor ear heard, neither hath it entered into the heart of man what God has laid up for those that love Him.*” But unto us, it hath been revealed by the Spirit. Not a weapon that is formed against you can prosper. Know the wisdom and purpose of the great Hand that is upon you. Glorify God in distresses and persecutions, for the Spirit of God is there made manifest. Be chastened! Be perfected! Press on to heights, lengths, breadths, and depths. Faith is the victory, the hope is within you, the joy set before you. The peace which passeth all understanding. The knowledge that the flesh has withered in the presence of the purifying of the Word. He, who has brought you hitherto, will take you to the end. I have wept bitterly and mourned when I needed revelation of God, but I need not have done.

The Lord lifteth up and changeth and operateth, and makes body and soul till He can say, “*There is no spot in thee.*” Yes, it was persecution, tribulation, and distress that drew us near. Lifting places, changing places, the operation of God by the Spirit. Do not let us pass this way but let God have His way

God stretched out His Hand, covered us with the mantle of His love, and brought us nearer and nearer into the channel of His grace until our hearts have moved and yielded, and so turned to the Lord that every moment has seen a divine place where God has met us. He stretched out his arms and said, “*Seek ye My face - look unto*

Me.” Behold and see what great love the Master has for thee, to lead thee to the fountain of living water. Yield! Be led! And let God be glorified! Amen.

LIVING FAITH

“Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. For by it the elders obtained a good report” (Hebrews 11:1-2).

God has moved me tonight to speak on the marvellous, glorious reality of God’s Word. How great should be our faith, for we can not be saved except by faith. We can not be kept but by faith; we can only be baptised by faith. We will be caught up by faith; therefore, what a blessed reality is faith in the Living God.

What is faith? It is the very nature of God. Faith is the Word of God. It is the personal inward flow of divine favour, which moves in every fibre of our being until our whole nature is so quickened that we live by faith, we move by faith, and we are going to be caught up to glory by faith, for “Faith is the Victory!” Faith is the glorious knowledge of a personal presence within you, changing you from strength to strength, from glory to glory, until you get to the place where you walk with God, and God thinks and speaks through you by the power of the Holy Ghost. Oh, it is grand; it is glorious!

God wants us to have far more than that which we can handle and see, and so He speaks of the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen; but with the eye of faith, we may see it in all its beauty and grandeur. God’s Word is from everlasting to everlasting, and “faith is the substance.” If I should give some of you ladies a piece of cloth, scissors, needle and thread, you could produce a garment. Why? Because you had the material. If I should provide some of you men with wood, saw, hammer, and nails, you could produce a box. Why? Because you had the material. But God, without material, spoke the Word and produced this world with all its beauty. There was no material there, but the Word of God called it into being by His creative force. With the knowledge that you are begotten by this incorruptible Word, which liveth and abideth forever, you know that within you is this living, definite hope, greater than yourself, more powerful than any dynamic force in the world - for faith worketh in you by the power of the New Creation of God in Christ Jesus. Therefore with the audacity of faith we should throw ourselves into the omnipotence of God’s divine plan, for God has said to you, *“If thou canst believe, all things are possible to him that believeth.”* (Mark 9:23)

It is possible for the power of God to be so manifest in your human life that you will never be as you were before; for you will be ever going forward, from victory to victory, for faith knows no defeat.

The Word of God will bring you into a wonderful place of rest in faith. God means for you to have a clear conception of what faith is, how faith came, and how it remains. Faith is in the divine plan, for it brings you to the open door that you might enter in. You must have an open door, for you can not open the door; it is God who does it, but He wants you to be ready to step in and claim His promises to all the divine manifestation of power in the name of Christ Jesus. It is only thus that you will be able to meet and conquer the enemy, for *“He that is within you is greater than he that is without.”*

Living faith brings glorious power and personality; it gives divine ability, for it is by faith that Christ is manifested in your mortal flesh by the Word of God. I would not have you miss the knowledge that you have heard from God, and to realise that God has so changed you that all weakness, fear, inability, and everything that has made you a failure has passed away. Faith has power to make you what God wants you to be; only you must be ready to step into the plan and believe His Word.

The first manifestation of God's plan was the Cross of Calvary. You may refuse it; you may resist it. But God, who loves you with an everlasting love, has followed you through life and will follow you with His great grace that He may bring you to a knowledge of this great salvation. God, in his own plan for your eternal good, may have brought something into your life that is distasteful; something that is causing you to feel desperate, that your life is worthless. What does it mean? It means that the Spirit of God is showing you your own weakness so that you might cry out unto Him, and when you do He will show you the Cross of Redemption. Then God will give you faith to believe, for faith is the gift of God.

God, who has given us this faith, has a wonderful plan for our lives. Do you remember when God brought you to this place of salvation, how the faith He gave you brought a great desire to do something for Him, and then He showed you that wonderful open door? I was saved over sixty-seven years ago, and I have never lost the witness of the Spirit. If you will not allow your human nature to crush your faith and interfere with God's plan in its wonderful divine setting, you will mount up like the eagles. Oh the wonderful effectiveness of God's perfect plan working in us with the Divine Trinity flowing through humanity changing our very nature to the extent that we can not disbelieve. Instead, we act faith, talk faith, and in faith sing praises unto the Lord. There is no room for anything that is not faith, for we have passed beyond the natural plane into a new atmosphere - God enclosed and enclosing us.

Faith is an increasing position, always triumphant. It is not a place of poverty but of wealth. If you always live in fruitfulness you will always have plenty. What does it say in this scripture? *"The elders obtained a good report!"* The man who lives in faith always has a good report. The Acts of the Apostles were written because the lives of the Apostles bore the fruit of active faith. To them faith was an everyday fact. If your life is in the divine order, you will not only have living active faith, but you will always be building up someone else in faith.

What is the good of preaching without faith? God intends that we should so live in this glorious sphere of the power of God, that we will always be in a position to tell people of the act that brought the fact. You must act before you can see the fact. What is the good of praying for the sick without faith? You must believe that God will not deny Himself, for the Word of God can not be denied. I believe this message is given in divine order, that you may no longer be in a place of doubt but will realise that *"faith is the substance!"* Beloved, even with all the faith we have, we are not even so much as touching the hem of God's plan for us. It is like going to the seashore and dipping your toe in the water, with the great vast ocean before you. God wants us to rise on the bosom of the tide, and not keep paddling along the shore. Oh to be connected with

that sublime power, that human nature may know God and the glory of the manifestation of Christ!

The Word of God is eternal and can not be broken. You can not improve on the Word of God, for it is life, and it produces life. Listen! God has begotten you to a “lively hope.” You are begotten of the Word that created worlds. If you dare to believe, it is powerful. God wants us to be powerful - a people of faith - a purified people. God wants a people who will launch out in Him and dare to trust Him in glorious faith which always takes you beyond that which is commonplace to an abiding place in God.

THE SECRET PLACE

(Preached in 1921)

“He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty. I will say of the Lord, He is my refuge and my fortress: my God; in him will I trust. Surely he shall deliver thee from the snare of the fowler, and from the noisome pestilence. He shall cover thee with his feathers, and under his wings shalt thou trust: his truth shall be thy shield and buckler. Thou shalt not be afraid for the terror by night; nor for the arrow that flieth by day; Nor for the pestilence that walketh in darkness; nor for the destruction that wasteth at noonday. A thousand shall fall at thy side, and ten thousand at thy right hand; but it shall not come nigh thee. Only with thine eyes shalt thou behold and see the reward of the wicked. Because thou hast made the Lord, which is my refuge, even the most High, thy habitation; There shall no evil befall thee, neither shall any plague come nigh thy dwelling. For he shall give his angels charge over thee, to keep thee in all thy ways. They shall bear thee up in their hands, lest thou dash thy foot against a stone. Thou shalt tread upon the lion and adder: the young lion and the dragon shalt thou trample under feet. Because he hath set his love upon me, therefore will I deliver him: I will set him on high, because he hath known my name. He shall call upon me, and I will answer him: I will be with him in trouble; I will deliver him, and honour him. With long life will I satisfy him, and shew him my salvation.” (Psalm 91)

The crown of life is for the overcomer. It is not for those at ease in Zion. We must be in the place where God can depend upon us to keep going until we see victory, never giving in and knowing no defeat, always making our stand by a living faith and gaining the victory. Faith is the victory.

“This is the work of God, that ye believe on him whom he hath sent.” (John 6:29)

England once had a war with France. Some prisoners were taken; among them, a drummer boy. Napoleon ordered him to sound a retreat. He said “No!” He had never learned one.

God never wants you to retreat before the enemy, but to learn the song of victory and overcome! Praise the Lord!

There are two kinds of shouts: a shout that is made, and a shout that makes you. There are men of God, but there are also men who are God’s men. There is a place where you take hold of God, but there is a better place where God takes hold of you.

Psalm 91:1 says, *“He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty.”* Do YOU know the presence of the Almighty? It is wonderful. It is a surety, with no wavering, no unbelief, no unrest there. It is perfect!

FEAR THE LORD

My great desire is to see men become strong in the Lord by dwelling in the secret place, which is known to all who fear Him.

Now, there are two kinds of fear. One fear involves being afraid of God. I hope you are not there. Unbelievers are there. But the believer should desire, rather, to die than to grieve God by fearing Him in this way.

Fellowship with God, peace, and power - this is God's will for us, so don't fear that it isn't. No price is too great to pay to have it. It is our inheritance. Christ purchased it for us. Through Him we have the covering of the presence of the Almighty. What a covering the unfolding of His will is!

The secret place of the Lord is with those who fear Him in the second way: with respect and honour. Moses knew something about it. He feared God and said to Him, "*If thy presence go not with me, carry us not up hence.*" (Exodus 33:15)

Oh, to dwell in the secret place, His presence! What will this presence do? It will dare us to believe all God says; assisting us to lay hold of the promises. We will have God so indwelling us that we will become a force, a power of God's abiding, until the time death is swallowed up in victory!

We have a great salvation filled with inspiration. It has no limitations; it makes known the immeasurable wonders of God.

If you are in the experience of verse 1, here is an added substance of faith for you. (It is a fact. And you need to have facts, inward facts, instead of "fearings" or feelings, because you will be beyond anyone's argument when you have them.) There are those who proclaim, "*I will say of the Lord, he is my refuge and my fortress: my God; in him will I trust.*" (Psalm 91:2) Who will say it? He that abideth! He who abides in the Lord knows he can trust in the Lord to protect him from harm.

FREE FROM THE LAW OF SIN AND DEATH

There is no "kick" in the secret place - no evil temper, no irritability. All is swept away while one is dwelling in the presence of the Almighty; in the covering of God. Even the best of humanity, when from the devil, is not good, and can not remain in God's presence. "*Jesus was manifested to destroy ALL the works of the devil.*" (1 John 3:8)

"For what the law could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, God sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh." (Romans 8:3)

God sent forth Jesus in the mightiness of His power. In flesh and in the midst of flesh, He condemned it. The law of the Spirit of life was destroying all that must be destroyed. Dead indeed unto sin, but alive unto God, we then are above all in Him: He that is above all and through all and in you all.

This is a fact, not in human nature, but in God. It is the gift of God from heaven. We belong to the new creation, and we are in a wonderful place in life. It is a life free from the law of sin and death.

Can we keep ourselves there? GOD can keep us there.

*He never forgets to keep me,
He never forgets to keep me
My Father has many dear children;
But He never forgets to keep me.*

Has He forgotten to keep you? Nay! He can not forget. God has much in store for you; you are far from being out of His thoughts.

GOD'S WORD: ANTIDOTE TO EVIL

There was a time when the children of Israel hung their harps on the willows in defeat. Sometimes the believer does the same. The song of joy leaves his heart. It doesn't have to happen. I have seen thousands delivered from evil powers.

You must be aware that there is a great weakness in the land: It is a lack of knowledge. People hew out cisterns that can hold no water, instead of filling themselves with the Word of God. You see, *"There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear ..."* (1 John 4:18) And where is God, who is Love? He is in the Word. He has embodied Himself in the Word. The Word spells destruction to all evil, because God is in the Word, and He is greater than all evil. Therefore, he that dwelleth in love is master of evil situations. He that dwelleth in GOD, in His presence and in His Word, is master of evil situations. We have no fear! We are over every sickness! Ours is a perfect redemption!

The Bible has so many precious promises, with wealth beyond all price, that God has planned for us to have. Seek after God's plan. Don't be unbelieving, for the waverer gets nothing. Real faith is established, never changing, and with it you'll get all God has for you.

ESTABLISHED FAITH

"How can I get established faith?" you ask.

Abide under the shadow of the Almighty. Don't change your position, but always have the presence of God, the glory of God. Pay any price to abide under that covering, for the secret of victory is to abide where the Victor abides.

*Higher, higher, nothing dreading
